

No matter who we are or where we are from, we only have 24 hours each day to get things done. Some people seem to make the most of their time to achieve their goals and dreams. Others feel that life is passing them by and they aren't accomplishing anything. If you are in the latter group, it is not too late to turn things around.

If you want to become more productive, it pays to learn about the Pareto principle. It states that for most tasks, 80 percent of the results we get come from 20 percent of the work we do. For example, 80 percent of the company sales usually come from 20 percent of customers. Therefore, the trick is to focus your efforts on the key 20 percent of actions to improve your results.

In some cases, people may be busy from morning to night but still seem to get nothing done. In this situation, the problem might be that clear goals haven't been set. 




